the Participation in the Berlin Carnival, 2018

The Embassy of Nepal in Berlin, Germany took part in a Street Parade hosted in connection with the Carnival of Cultures of the World (Berlin Carnival)-2018 on May 20, 2018 to promote Nepal through cultural dances, performances, music, songs and ethnic dresses.
