His Excellency Ram Kaji Khadka, Ambassador Extraordinary & Plenipotentiary of Nepal to the Republic of Serbia presented his “Letters of Credence” to His Excellency Alexander Vucic, President of the Republic of Serbia, amidst a special ceremony held at the “Palata Srbije”- the “Palace of Serbia” today as the non-resident Ambassador having his residence in Berlin.

During a brief informal audience following the presentation of “Letters of Credence”, H.E. the President congratulated the Ambassador and inquired about the possibilities of opening avenues of cooperation in areas of trade, commerce and investment beyond the excellent bilateral political relation that is so happily existing between the two countries. H.E. the Ambassador conveyed the message of warm greetings and best wishes from the Rt. Hon. President Mrs. Bidya Devi Bhadari and the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister Mr. Sher Bahadur Deuba for H.E. the President’s good health and happiness as well as the continued progress and prosperity of the people of Serbia while reiterating his commitment to engage constructively with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Serbia and other relevant agencies during his stint as Ambassador for further enhancing and strengthening the bilateral ties between the two countries. He also highlighted the importance of frequent exchange of visits at various levels. H.E. the Ambassador also informed that there has been a change of government in Nepal recently and a high level participation is underway from Nepal in the Special Commemorative event being hosted by the Government of Serbia on the occasion of 60th anniversary of the establishment of Non-Aligned Movement (NAM). H.E. the President expressed his anticipation of high level engagement soon during the anniversary of NAM.

All together, twenty four non-resident Ambassadors based in different capitals presented their “Letters of Credence” on the occasion. His Excellency Nicola Selakovic, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Serbia and other high level officials were also present on the occasion.
