Advisory to All the Nepali Nationals in Ukraine

The Embassy is closely observing the situation in Ukraine. The Embassy, therefore, requests all the Nepali nationals who are still in Ukraine to constantly follow the security advisory of the government of Ukraine and remain alert, safe and strong. As the authorities have announced the lifting of weekend curfew in Kyiv today, the green passage to the border areas of the West and South are open. Nepali citizens who are still in the East, North and Centre of the country are advised to take the opportunity and leave for the safer locations towards the border of Poland, Slovakia, Hungary and Romania. The following border points are opened for entry:

- Poland **Medica, Krakowie and Dorohusk (Other border entry points include Zosin, Dolhobyczow, Hrebenne, Budomierz and Kroscienko)**
- Slovakia (**Vysne Nemecke, Ubla and Velke Slemence**)
- Hungary (Chop (Tysa), Chop (Druzhba), Dzvinkove, Kosyno)
- Romania (**Siret, Lunca la Tisa, Sighetu Marmatiei and RĂDĂUŢI PRUT (Jud. Botoşani) which will remain open for 24/7 (announced today).**
