Advisory to all the Nepali Nationals in Ukraine

The situation in Ukraine is still critical. Heavy fightings are being reported in the capital and some other regions. Your safety and safe passage to the less risky areas of West and South is our first priority. The Embassy, therefore, urges all the Nepali citizens who are still in the territory of Ukraine to maintain calm, remain cautious and stay strong. You are also advised to stay inside and take the opportunity to embark on public transportation while the curfew or any security advisory in effect is lifted.

Those who are still stranded in Kyiv, Kharkiv or elsewhere in Ukraine and are in contact with the Indian community or individual friends, may join them for evacuation or translocation to the West and South of the country.
