**Press Release**

His Excellency Mr. Ram Kaji Khadka, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Nepal to the Republic of Poland held a meeting with the President of Polish Chamber of Commerce Mr. Marek Kloczko at the latter's office yesterday morning. During the meeting H.E. the Ambassador briefed about the trade, investment, tourism and economic policy of the Government of Nepal and encouraged the private sector of Poland to explore more opportunities to expand partnerships in those respective areas. He also informed Mr. Kloczko of the production base and potential areas of investment in Nepal. The President of Polish Chamber of Commerce committed to collaborate with the private sector of Nepal including Nepal Chamber of Commerce as they have official relations for quite a long time but has been slowed down due to the earthquake of 2015 and the COVID-19 global pandemic. He also expressed his willingness to support for the possible visit of Polish business delegation to Nepal in the future. He also advised to follow the expos and exhibitions in different cities of Poland for the promotion of Nepali products. H.E. the Ambassador was accompanied by Honorary Consul Dr. Bodha Raj Subedi during the meeting.

His Excellency Ambassador also participated in a program organized to inaugurate the newly opened Honorary Consul of Nepal in Warsaw (Masovian Voivodship) at the residence of the Honorary Consul after 63 years of establishment of diplomatic relations between Nepal and Poland. Delivering the opening remarks, he highlighted the bilateral relations between Nepal and Poland while shedding light on the importance of economic collaboration for the mutual benefit of both the countries. The Ambassador also made special mention about the people-to-people relations that are growing steadily beyond the official bilateral relations. He expressed his confidence that the newly appointed Honorary Consul of Nepal in Poland Dr. Bodha Raj Subedi will play a proactive role to enhance the existing bilateral relations as per the anticipation of both the governments. He also stated that the Honorary Consul will have a greater role to solve the problems of Nepali community and also extend necessary support to protect their interest and wellbeing. H.E. the Ambassador unveiled the banner and signboard of the Honorary Consulate, handed over the originals of the 'Letter of Commission' and the 'Exequatur' and flags of Nepal to the Honorary Consul. He was accompanied by H.E. Anna Zalenwska, Member of European Parliament and Former Minister of National Education of Poland and Mr. Piotr Buszta, Head of South Asia Section, Asia-Pacific Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to cut the ribbon for inauguration.

Speaking at the inaugural program, Mr. Buszta expressed his happiness to be part of the event and stated that the political relations between Nepal and Poland have been growing strength
