His Excellency Mr. Ram Kaji Khadka, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Nepal to the Republic of Poland presented his 'Letters of Credence' to His Excellency Andrzej Duda, the President of the Republic of Poland amidst a special ceremony held at the Belweder Palace, the Official Residence of the President today, as the Non-Resident Ambassador of Nepal having his residence in Berlin, Germany.

During the audience with His Excellency the President following the presentation of the 'Letters of Credence', the Ambassador conveyed the message of warm greetings and best wishes from the Rt. Hon. President Mrs. Bidya Devi Bhandari and the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister Mr. Sher Bahadur Deuba for the good health and happiness of His Excellency the President and for the continued progress, prosperity and wellbeing of the people of the Republic of Poland. The ceremony was attended by high level officials of the Office of the President and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs including the territorial Department. The Ambassador also visited the Tomb of the Unknown Soldiers, laid wreath, paid homage to the unknown soldiers and signed the Memorial Book following the audience with His Excellency the President. Ambassador Mr. Khadka was accompanied by his wife Mrs. Bina Khadka during the ceremony.

Prior to the presentation of the originals of his 'Letters of Credence' to His Excellency the President, Ambassador Mr. Khadka paid a courtesy call on and handed over the copy of his 'Letters of Credence' to the Undersecretary of State (Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs) H.E. Mr. Paweł Jabłoński at his Office following the separate meetings with Ambassador H.E. Mr. Marek Szczepanowski, Director of Diplomatic Protocol and Mr. Krzysztof Dobrowolski, Deputy Director of Asia-Pacific Department at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Poland yesterday. The Ambassador took the opportunity to share views on Nepal-Poland bilateral relations in course of all those meetings and courtesy calls on.

Ambassador Mr. Khadka is scheduled to attend a meeting and interaction program organized by the Non-Resident Nepali Association, National Coordination Council (NRNA-NCC), Poland and the Nepali community in Warsaw this evening.

His Excellency Mr. Khadka will hold a meeting with the President of Polish Chamber of Commerce and inaugurate newly established Honorary Consulate of Nepal in Warsaw (Masovian District) tomorrow. The Ambassador is scheduled to return to Berlin on 10 December 2022.
